DESCRIPTION

The Royal College of Surgeons in Ireland in conjunction with Ipsen Pharmaceuticals Limited have made available a Urology Travelling Fellowship for 2018. The award will fund a Higher Trainee in Urology to attend, for research or training purposes, a meeting or to visit a centre of urological excellence.

The Fellowship is open to Fellows and Members of the College, in good standing, who are participating in an RCSI Specialist Urology training programme at the time of application.

The award will be a single fellowship in the amount of €6,000. The award will be made by a joint panel of RCSI and ISU based on the following criteria:

- (a) Training record of applicant.
- (b) Reputation of the host institution.
- (c) Value to the development of Urology in Ireland.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Applicants are required to:

- (a) Complete the application form.
- (b) Provide written agreement of a sponsor in the host institution.
- (c) Provide a copy of full curriculum vitae.

Completed applications should be submitted by e-mail to the Department of Surgical Affairs (for the attention of Ms G Conroy), gconroy@rcsi.ie, on or before Friday 26th January 2018.

The successful candidate will be expected to:

- › Provide the College with a full report on completion of the Fellowship.
- › Present a report of the Fellowship at the following Annual Ipsen Pharmaceuticals meeting.
- › Acknowledge the support of the College and Ipsen Pharmaceuticals Ltd in any publication arising as a result of the Fellowship.
- › Supply the College with copies of the above papers at the time of publication.
